## Politicians using us as sacrificial lambs - COE

**THE experts involved in the formulation of the proposed constitution yesterday came out fighting accusing politicians of using them as sacrificial lambs in pursuit of their own interests.**

Through its chairman Nzamba Kionga, the Committee of Experts accused certain politicians and other interest groups of propagating propaganda and lies about their work in their attempts to have the proposed law rejected yet they were part and parcel of the process.

Denying that the committee ever mutilated the agreements reached at Naivasha on the critical chapters on system of government, land and devolution, among others, Kionga noted that if there are any gray areas, the Parliamentary Select Committee (PSC) and Parliament had opportunity to remedy the same.

## Judge Keiwua cleared of graft claim

**SUSPENDED** Appeal Judge Mojo ole Keiwua now has the choice of rejoining the Bench or

retiring honourably.

The High Court yesterday quashed the proceedings of the tribunal headed by retired Court of

Appeal Judge Akiwumi that was appointed by President Kibaki in 2003 to investigate him over corruption allegations.

Justice Keiwua was exposed to great injustice and illegality by the tribunal's failure to present him with a copy of the

allegations made against him, afford him an opportunity to prepare his defence and usurped the role of investigating him.

High Court Judges Muga Apodi, Mohamed Warsame and George Dulu declared in their 146-page judgment.

They said Kenya had a working Constitution and the court had a cardinal duty to restore
